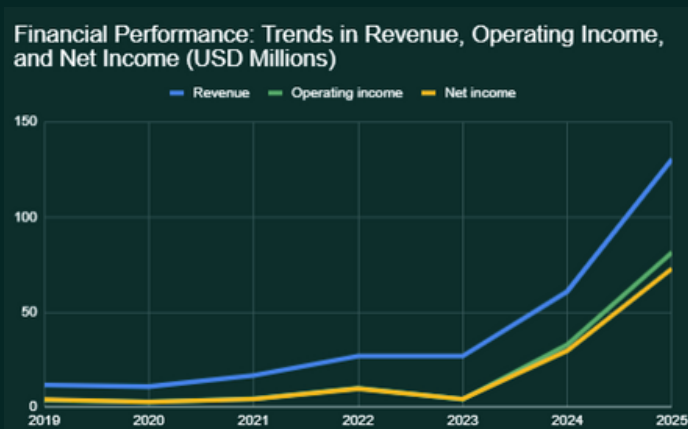
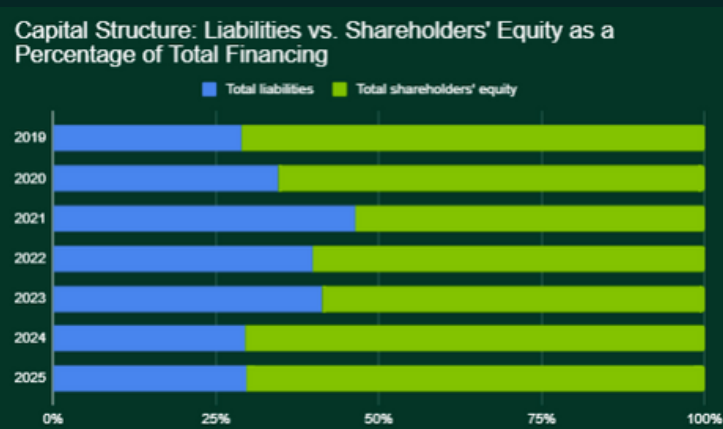
### VALUATION (FCFF/DCF)

- **Short-term pressure:** Negative FCFF (-\$16B in 2025) reflects heavy CapEx and working capital demands.
- **Strategic reinvestment:** Cash flow is redirected into AI capacity, R&D, and infrastructure for future dominance.
- **Growth foundation:** EBITDA CAGR of +13.2% signals resilient operational performance despite cash flow constraints.
- **Risk-reward trade-off:** NVIDIA is sacrificing short-term liquidity to capture long-term market leadership.



### FINANCIAL PERFORMANCE(2020-2025)

- **Revenue growth accelerated strongly after 2023**, driven by unprecedented demand for AI chips and data centers.
- **Operating income and net income scaled up even faster than revenues**, highlighting efficiency gains and cost discipline.
- **Margins expanded across all levels** (gross, operating, net), reaching historical highs by 2025.
- **Equity-financed growth reduced financing risk**, avoiding excessive debt during expansion.
- **Structural upswing since 2023 marks an inflection point:** NVIDIA transitioned from cyclical growth to a sustained scale-up phase.

#### RISK

Explosive demand for AI chips and data center solutions has triggered accelerated revenue growth and margin expansion since 2023. NVIDIA is uniquely positioned to capture this structural trend, standing at the very core of the AI revolution and setting new industry benchmarks.

#### OUTLOOK

Despite short-term challenges, NVIDIA's equity-led financing, strong balance sheet, and scalable profitability ensure resilience. These fundamentals underpin the company's long-term trajectory as a global leader in the AI-driven economy, with growth potential that far outweighs near-term risks.
